## **EKG/ECG Technician**

Effective March 2025

### **Description**

The Electrocardiograph Technician operates the equipment that records and measures the activity of the heart. These recordings are used to assist the cardiologist and physicians in diagnosing and treating cardiac problems. Learners in this course will study heart anatomy and physiology, focusing on normal and abnormal cardiac rhythms. Learners will perform ECGs in the student lab. ECG Technicians are employed in hospitals, clinics, sleep study centers and rehabilitation centers.

### **Schedule**

6-Week Hybrid Format. 8 hour in-person class weekly with online content in between meetings.

### **Training cost:**

\$1,200. Payment is required at least 2 weeks prior to the start date of the course.
