Point of Care Technician

Description

The Point of Care Technician course prepares learners to work with biological samples and perform medical laboratory testing in near patient and medical laboratory settings. Learners will perform sample collection and a variety of testing procedures in student laboratory sessions. Learners will be taught about medical laboratory regulations and industry standard best practices. Point of Care Technicians are employed in hospitals, clinics, and physician offices.
