

Faculty Recognition Award

- Eligibility** Any full-time faculty member at Pierpont Community and Technical College.
- Award** For 2016 the amount of the award is \$250
- Nomination Process** The nominator should write a brief letter and submit it to facdevpierpont@pierpont.edu explaining why the faculty member deserves consideration for the award.
- The committee will ask faculty members who have been named if they will consent to the nomination.
- Nomination Deadline** Extended to February 12, 2016
- Application Process** Applicants submit an electronic portfolio (pdf, prezi, etc.) containing 1-2, but no more than 3, documents or related artifacts that represent each of the categories within the Rubric for the award, found on the Center for Teaching Excellence website.
- Application Deadline** Extended to February 26, 2016
- Selection Criteria** Portfolios are evaluated on the categories referenced in the rubric available through the Center for Teaching Excellence website. The categories include: Commitment to the Institution, Commitment to the Community, Willingness to Mentor and Share Knowledge with Students, and Achievements.
- Purpose & History** Each fall the Faculty Development Committee solicits nominations for Faculty Recognition Awards. This award is given in recognition of achievements as faculty and outstanding contributions to students, the college, colleagues, and the community. The recipient of the award will have the opportunity to showcase his or her accomplishments at the end of the spring semester.
