The vision statement was shaped based on feedback gathered during the January 2024 visioning exercise and subsequently reviewed by the President's Council and confirmed during Institutional Meet and Confer meetings of all Pierpont constituency groups, ensuring that it reflects the college's aspirational goals.

**BACKGROUND:** 

In early 2024, Pierpont Community & Technical College engaged in a comprehensive and inclusive strategic planning process to outline institutional goals and strategies that will guide the College's future growth and development. Key activities and milestones of this process included:

- **Community Interviews (January 2024):** Community stakeholders were invited to provide their perspectives and insights on the College's strengths and areas for improvement.
- **Faculty and Staff Strategic Planning Exercises (January 2024):** Faculty and staff participated in strategic planning exercises during Learning Communities Week, contributing input based on their experiences and expertise.
- Strategic Plan Retreat (February 2024): Faculty, staff, students, and alumni convened for a Strategic Plan Retreat, focusing on identifying the College's Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats (SWOT) and developing corresponding institutional goals and strategies.
- Strategic Plan Review and Revision (February 2024 October 2024):

The draft plan underwent several rounds of review and revision by the President's Council and Cabinet between February and October. Discussions and revisions took place during the March, April, June, and September Meet and Confer meetings with classified staff, non-classified staff, and faculty members ensuring representation from all constituent groups. Feedback from our Higher Learning Commission review provided additional objectives to consider and include in the plan. Additionally, during Learning Communities Week in August, all employees had the opportunity to review and provide feedback on the draft plan. The onboarding of the Director of Institutional Effectiveness in September helped solidify the plan by introducing specific measures and key performance indicators to track progress.
